All the reagents are stored at 2-8°C. The kit is stable for 6 months from the date of receipt.


#### Background

The integrins are a superfamily of cell adhesion receptors that bind to extracellular matrix ligands, cell-surface ligands, and soluble ligands. They are transmembrane  $\alpha$   $\beta$  heterodimers and at least 24 distinct integrin heterodimers are formed by the combination of 18  $\alpha$  and eight  $\beta$  known subunits. In addition to mediating cell adhesion, integrins also play important roles in modulating signal transduction pathways that control cellular responses including migration, proliferation, differentiation, and apoptosis. Integrin alpha-1 (ITGA1, CD49a) combines with the beta 1 subunit (ITGB1, CD29) to form a cell-surface receptor for collagen and laminin. This receptor is involved in cell-cell adhesion and may play a role in inflammation and fibrosis.
