Background Information	EGLN2, also named as PHD1, EIT6 and HPH-3, catalyzes the post-translational formation of 4-hydroxyproline in hypoxia-inducible factor (HIF) alpha proteins. It hydroxylates HIF-1 alpha at 'Pro-402' and 'Pro-564', and HIF-2 alph EGLN2 functions as a cellular oxygen sensor and, under normoxic conditions, targets HIF through the hydroxylation for proteasomal degradation via the von Hippel-Lindau ubiquitination complex. It may play a role in cell growth regulation.
