HOXD12, also named as HOX4H, belongs to the Abd-B homeobox family. HOXD12 is a sequence-specific transcription factor which is part of a developmental regulatory system that provides cells with specific positional identities on the anterior-posterior axis. The exact role of this gene has not been determined.
