Background Information

Calcium voltage-gated channel subunit alpha 1 C (CACNA 1C, also known as CACH2 and Cav 1.2) couples transient activation of inward calcium current to transcriptional regulation and plays an important role in dendritic development, neuronal survival, synaptic plasticity, memory formation, learning, and behavior (PMID: 21248242; 16251435; 20169575; 19047462; 18174367). Genetic variation in CACNA1C has also been associated with depression, schizophrenia, and autism spectrum disorders, as well as changes in brain function and structure in control subjects who have no diagnosable psychiatric illness (PMID: 22705413).




