Background Information

Alpha 1 microglobulin, also known as HI30, is a 27-30 kDa glycoprotein, present in various body fluids. It belongs to $the\ lipocal in\ superfamily\ of\ hydrophobic\ ligand-binding\ proteins\ forming\ an\ internal\ ligand-binding\ pocket.\ The$ protein acts as a mediator of bacterial adhesion to polymer surfaces and is involved in inhibiting renal lithogenesis.


Storage:
