

It is used to study peripheral nerve development and regeneration, as it is highly expressed during elongation of axon. Peripherin is a routine marker for unmyelinated neurons in trigeminal ganglion (TG) and the dorsal root ganglion (DRG). Peripherin is also expressed in peri-insular areas of islets and it has been identified as a key autoantigen for type 1A diabetes.
