Background Information

Importin beta1, also known karyopherin beta or KPNB1, is a nuclear transport receptor that plays a key role in the nuclear import process. Importin beta1 and importin alpha work in concert to transport cargo into the nucleus, functioning as an essential component of the classical nuclear localization signal (NLS) pathway. Elevated expression of importin beta1 has been found in cervical tumors. (22125623)

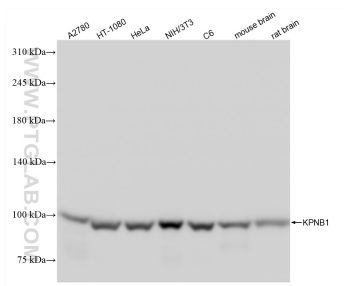

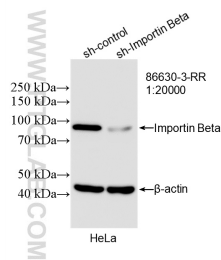

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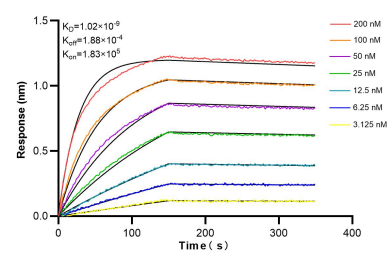
Selected Validation Data



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 86630-3-RR (KPNB1 antibody) at dilution of 1:10000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 86630-3-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



WB result of Importin Beta antibody (86630-3-RR; 1:20000; incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours) with sh-Control and sh-Importin Beta transfected HeLa cells. This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 86630-3-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



Biolayer interferometry (BLI) kinetic assays of 86630-3-RR against Human Importin Beta were performed. The affinity constant is 1.02 nM.
