Tau is hyperphosphorylated during aging and in age-related neurodegenerative diseases such as Alzheimer's disease (AD) and fronto-temporal dementia. Hyperphosphorylation of Tau leads to the formation of neurofibrillary tangles (NFT) in the neurons and glia cells, which is one of the hallmarks of AD.

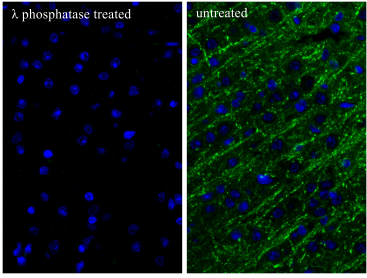
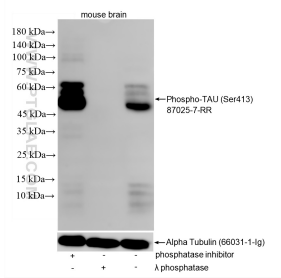

Selected Validation Data



Non-treated mouse brain tissue, phosphatase inhibitor treated mouse brain tissue and λ phosphatase treated mouse brain tissue were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 87025-7-RR (Phospho-TAU (Ser413) antibody at dilution of 1:2000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. The membrane was stripped and re-blotted with Alpha Tubulin (66031-1-Ig) antibody as a loading control. This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 87025-7-

Immunofluorescent analysis of (4% PFA) fixed λ phosphatase treated mouse brain tissue using Phospho-TAU (Ser413) antibody (87025-7-RR, Clone: 252169D12) at dilution of 1:300 and CoraLite®488-Conjugated Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L) (SA00013-2). This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 87025-7-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.
