Background Information

H3S28ph and H3S10ph appear simultaneously in the early stages of mitosis, starting from prophase I (chromosome condensation), distributed along the chromosomes, and participating in chromosome condensation and separation. H3S28ph, as a marker of cell proliferation and transformation, has important value in tumor research.

Storage

Storage:

Store at -20°C. Stable for one year after shipment.

Storage Buffer:

PBS with 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol, pH7.3

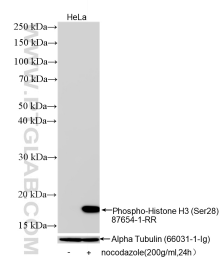

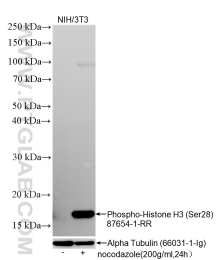

Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 87654-1-RR (Phospho-Histone H3 (Ser28) antibody) at dilution of 1:10000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. The membrane was stripped and reblotted with Alpha Tubulin Monoclonal antibody (66031-1-Ig) as loading control.



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
