Background Information

SUB1 gene encodes activated RNA polymerase II transcriptional coactivator p15, also termed as positive cofactor 4 (PC4) or p14. SUB1 is a sort of general coactivator that functions in assembling and stabilization of transcription complex. It has DNA binding activity and is localized in the nucleus, multiple modification sites of phosphorylation or acetylation may turn it appear slightly shifted molecular weight.

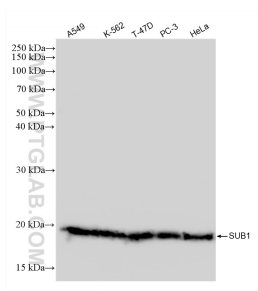

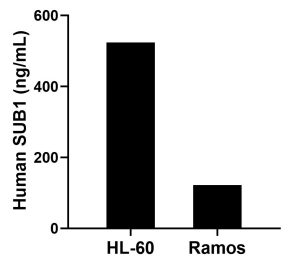
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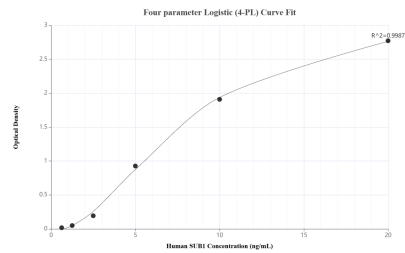
Selected Validation Data



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 88052-1-RR (SUB1 antibody) at dilution of 1:10000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 88052-1-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.



The mean SUB1 concentration was determined to be 523.40 ng/mL in HL-60 cell extract based on a 1.20 mg/mL extract load and 122.10 ng/mL in Ramos cell extract based on a 1.50 mg/mL extract load.



Sandwich ELISA standard curve of MP03355-2, Human SUB1 Recombinant Matched Antibody Pair - PBS only. 88052-3-PBS was coated to a plate as the capture antibody and incubated with serial dilutions of standard Ag1390. 88052-1-PBS was HRP conjugated as the detection antibody. Range: 0.625-20 ng/mL.
