Background Information

GCLC (Glutamate--cysteine ligase catalytic subunit) belongs to the glutamate--cysteine ligase type 3 family. It is also named as GLCL and GLCLC. It is the first rate-limiting enzyme in glutathione (GSH) biosynthesis. GCLC may be associated with coronary endothelial vasomotor dysfunction and myocardial infarction (MI) (PMID:12598062). Defects in GCLC are the cause of hemolytic anemia (HAGGSD).

Storage

Storage:

Store at -20°C. Stable for one year after shipment.

Storage Buffer:

PBS with 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol, pH7.3

Aliquoting is unnecessary for -20°C storage

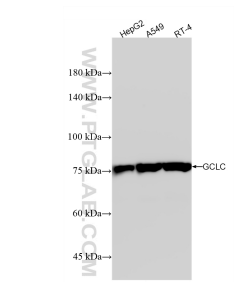

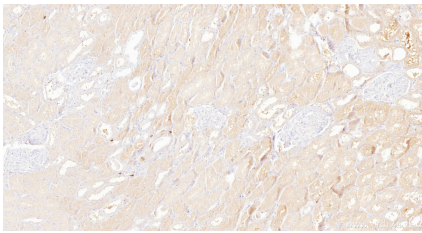
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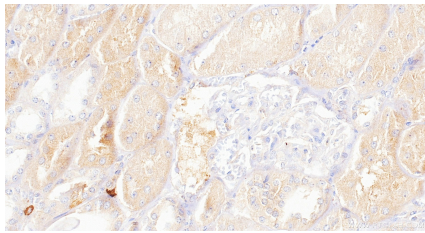
Selected Validation Data



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 88062-1-RR (GCLC antibody) at dilution of 1:5000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours.
