Background Information

Interleukin-1 is a pro-inflammatory cytokine with multiple biological effects. The IL-1 gene family encodes three proteins: IL-1 α , IL-1 β and their naturally occurring inhibitor Il-1RN. IL-1 Beta(IL-1 β), mainly produced by blood $monocytes \ and \ tissue \ macrophages, has \ been \ implicated \ in \ mediating \ both \ acute \ and \ chronic inflammation. \ IL-1\ \beta$ is known to be involved in a variety of cellular activities, including cell proliferation, differentiation and apoptosis. IL-1 β is emerging as a key mediator of carcinogenesis that characterizes host-environment interactions. Human IL- 1β is synthesized as a 31 kDa precursor. To gain activity, the precursor must be cleaved by caspase-1 between Asp116 and Ala117 to yield a 17 kDa mature form.

Storage

Store at -20°C. Avoid exposure to light. Stable for one year after shipment.

PBS with 50% Glycerol, 0.05% Proclin300, 0.5% BSA, pH 7.3.

Aliquoting is unnecessary for -20°C storage
