Background Information

CTSD (Cathepsin D) is also named as CPSD, belongs to the peptidase A1 family. It is ubiquitously expressed and is involved in proteolytic degradation, cell invasion, and apoptosis. Human CTSD is synthesized as a 52-kDa precursor that is converted into an active 48-kDa single-chain intermediate in the endosomes, and then into a fully active mature form, composed of a 34-kDa heavy chain and a 14-kDa light chain, in the lysosomes. It is a lysosomal acid protease found in neutrophils and monocytes and involved in the pathogenesis of several diseases such as breast cancer and possibly Alzheimer disease. 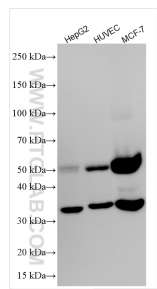
Storage

Aliquoting is unnecessary for -20°C storage

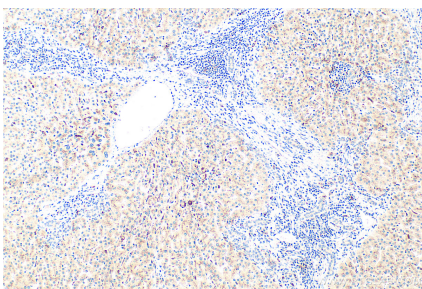

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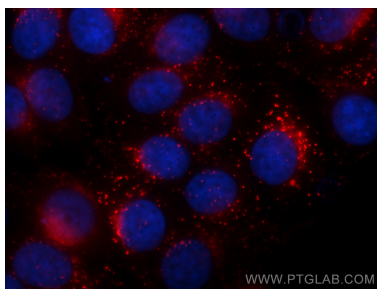
Selected Validation Data



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with RMX00012 (Cathepsin D antibody) at dilution of 1:5000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours.



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human hepatocirrhosis tissue slide using RMX00012 (Cathepsin D antibody) at dilution of 1:200 (under 10x lens). Heat mediated antigen retrieval with Tris-EDTA buffer (pH 9.0).



Immunofluorescent analysis of (-20°C Methanol) fixed MCF-7 cells using Cathepsin D antibody (RMX00012) at dilution of 1:400 and CoraLite® 594-Conjugated Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L) (SA00013-4).
